SCOUTING THE MUSEUM

Cost:

It is \$2 per scout and scout leaders are free. There is an additional fee for certain aviation activities. These fees are listed in the activities section.

When:

The meeting space is available Monday through Friday between 3 to 5pm depending on availability.

What's Included:

- A meeting room reserved for two hours.
- One activity selected from the list below.
- You are also free to explore the museum, the vintage aircraft, and various hands-on activities.

Aviation Activities:

Paper Crafts:

Make a pinwheel, paper copter, windsock, and lunch bag kite. This meets all the requirements for the Brownies Movers, Try-It Badge.

Color Me Kites:

Assemble and decorate your own kite. This meets the Go Fly a Kite requirement for the Junior Girl Scouts Aerospace Badge.

Science Experiments:

Learn about Bernoulli's principle, inertia, air pressure, and Newton's Third Law. This meets requirements for the Webelos Scouts Scientist Badge.

Forces of Flight Multi-Media Presentation:

Learn what makes an airplane fly. This fulfills requirements for the Boy Scouts Aviation Merit Badge and the Bear Cubs Aircraft, Elective 6, E.

Wooden Model:

Make a wooden airplane model for an **additional \$3**. This fulfills the Wolf Cubs Spare-Time Fun, Elective 5 G-H-I and Tiger Cubs Elective 17-Make a Model.

Paper and Balsa Airplanes:

Make and test your own airplanes. This fulfills the Test Flight requirement for the Junior Girl Scouts Aerospace Badge.

Rib-making Workshop:

Make a reproduction of a 1909 Wright airplane rib for an **additional \$5**.

Scavenger Hunt:

Explore the museum for the aviation related items pictured on your handout.

Remember that just visiting the museum and airport meets requirements for Boy Scouts, Tiger Cubs, and Junior Girls Scouts!

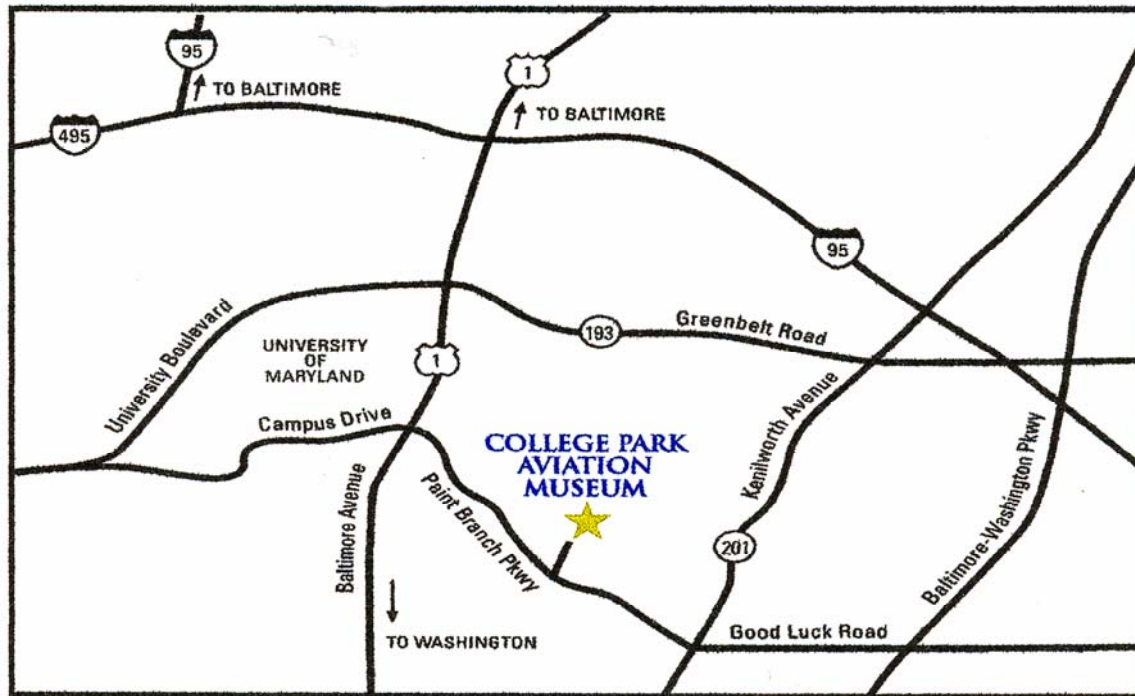

Go two blocks and follow signs into
our parking lot.
