ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Format:** There is no size limit on the artwork.
Medium: Entries must be original pieces of artwork. All forms of artwork are accepted, including collages, sculpture, mobiles, photography, drawing, painting, graphic art, print making, and mixed media.
Supplies: The museum will provide an art day on April 24, 11 am–4 pm, where supplies will be available to students to create original artwork. Artwork must be ready for display.
Certification: A parent, guardian, or art teacher must certify the authenticity of the artwork and the age of each artist. This only applies to contestants under 18.
